

KVM Switch Instructions:

The Belkin SOHO KVM Switch allows you to switch both audio and video from two machines to a single monitor and audio system. The model we have also allows sharing of attached USB devices, in our case a keyboard and mouse.



Operation:

1. The Belkin KVM uses a multi point switch, so each button can be tilted left (video), right (audio) or be pressed centrally for both.
2. There is a logo for Video and Audio with backlights to show the currently selected options. Here are the setting options:
 - a. Green – Attached Laptop Video and Audio In
 - b. Yellow – Room PC Video and Audio
 - c. Other – The System allows you to listen to audio from one machine whilst watching video from another
3. You can plug in a USB drive on the left side of the Switch to connect it to the in-room PC. Please make sure to un-mount before switching machines as switching with a drive attached is equivalent to unplugging it without ejecting and can cause loss of data.
